

Egg Climb
(Mean Time 3 minutes, Drop Dead Time 5 minutes)

Event Summary:

This event will consist of a 40' pole framed with an 8ft. wood cross arm at the top of the pole with light duty braces. There will be a hand line hanging from the end of the cross arm to the ground. There will be a neutral on the pole at 18' up from the ground. An anchor rod will be in the ground 6' from the pole below the end of the cross arm where the hand line is hanging.

1. The participant will be given an egg and a Buckingham bag p/n 1231 upon entering the event.
2. There will be an 8' circle around the pole that the participant must stay inside of when time starts. Gaf guards must be on while inside the circle.
3. Time will start at the judge's signal. The participant will then use the provided bag and egg, attach to hand line and raise to cross arm. You will then use the anchor rod to tie the hand line to. This will hold the bag at the cross arm. The hand line will be marked with tape 1 foot above the hook/snap. This tape mark must pass through the hand line roller and be visible from the ground. The purpose of this mark is to keep the bag consistent at the cross arm with each participant.
4. The participant will then ascend the pole, make a full transition around the neutral and climb to cross arm.
5. Once participant is at the cross arm you will take the egg out of the bag, place the egg in your mouth and descend the pole. A full transition around the neutral is required.
6. Full transition means into secondary safety to go around neutral and back into primary safety to climb or descend.
7. Time will stop when both feet are on the ground. Safety will still be attached to the pole.
8. Once time stops participant will show the egg to the judge for inspection. The egg cannot be cracked.
9. After the egg has been inspected the participant will untie the hand line from the anchor and bring down the bag.
10. Participant is allowed to put climbing tools on in 5 minute prep time.
11. No kind of mouth or teeth guard will be permitted.
12. The hand line may not be split. You may attach the bag to the hook or snap of the hand line.
13. There will be a 2 point deduction for the bag falling to the ground.
